The County provides laneway snow removal to residential ratepayers, at a fee as set out in the Fee Bylaw. Plowing of residential laneways will be provided only after all County roads are opened (as per Policy PW015).

SNOW REMOVAL PRIORITIES

- 1. Main Roads
- 2. Bus Routes
- 3. Other Grid Roads
- 4. Yard Sites

Please keep in mind if another snow event occurs before yard sites have been cleared the priority will reset back to 1. Yard sites will see additional delays as we were trying to keep the main roads open.

SNOW PLOWING GUIDELINES

- Plowing will be provided from the approach to the residence for access only (does not include clearing yards, buildings, bale storage areas, etc.)
- Laneways need to be a maximum of 500m (1640 ft.), wider than 8m (26 feet) wide and have acceptable turnaround in place. If the laneway does not meet these requirements additional conditions and/or fees may be applied.
- The County reserves the right to refuse yard service if it does not meet the requirements, if other problems exist or if the plow will exceed thirty minutes of work.
- Once the inspection is approved the Snow Plow Liability Waiver and Indemnity Agreement will require signature of the property ratepayer.

2023-2024 SNOWPLOW FLAG TYPES AND RATES (PER SEASON)

SENIORS AND DISABLED: \$50.00

Senior Citizen: A County of Vermilion River resident aged 65 or older.

Disabled Persons: A County of Vermilion River resident that provides proof of a disability number.

RATEPAYERS: \$200.00

BUFFALO TRAILS PUBLIC SCHOOL PARENTAL CHOICE: \$200.00

Parental Choice: A yard service request exists on a bus route where the bus uses the private yard to pick up the student at the parent/guardian's request.

BUFFALO TRAILS PUBLIC SCHOOL ESSENTIAL TURNAROUND: NO COST

Essential: A turnaround that exists because the approach is unsuitable for a pickup.

End of Route: Exists on a bus route where the bus must go into the private yard to turn around, because the approach is not suitable for a turnaround maneuver.

The essential turnaround and end of route is determined by Buffalo Trail Public School Division.
