POLICY STATEMENT

To acknowledge and provide recognition to students who excel at English 30-1 and English 30-2 courses and reside within the County of Vermilion River.

BACKGROUND

The County established the English 30-1 and English 30-2 awards in 1997 in order to recognize those students who excel by receiving the highest mark in their Grade 12 English classes. Enrollment in a post-secondary institution is not a requirement of eligibility.

OBJECTIVE

To provide three hundred dollar (\$300.00) awards to each eligible student, per school, in recognition of academic excellence.

DEFINITIONS

County is the County of Vermilion River.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- English 30-1 and English 30-2 awards are provided to those students who have achieved the highest mark(s) over eighty percent (80%) at the following schools:
 - Dewberry School
 - o E.H. Walter School
 - o J. R. Robson High School
 - o Kitscoty Junior/Senior High School
 - Marwayne Jubilee School
 - Vermilion Outreach School
 - St. Jerome's Catholic School
- The student(s) receiving the English 30-1 or English 30-2 award must reside within the County.
- Student(s) must receive a mark of eighty percent (80%) or higher to be eligible for an English 30-1 or English 30-2 award.
- Schools must provide the name(s) of the eligible student(s) to the County office a minimum of two (2) weeks prior to the date of the award ceremony.
- Council is notified of the award ceremony dates as they are received in order to allow for presentation of the award(s) on behalf of the County.
