Policy Statement:

The County of Vermilion River in the past has established a level of service and levels of contributions to local organizations that operate Rescue Units.

Purpose:

To establish the locations that operates Rescue Units in the County.

Policy:

- 1. The County of Vermilion River supports the Rescue Units in the Town of Vermilion, Village of Marwayne, Village of Kitscoty, Village of Dewberry and Village of Paradise Valley to provide service to the County. Council encourages adjacent departments to support the service provided by the other Rescue Units. Commencing in 2009, the County will contribute to the capital cost of purchasing rescue vehicles, on a 15 year cycle, as approved in the 20 Year Fire and Rescue Capital Replacement Plan.
- 2. The County of Vermilion River will make an annual donation for the sum of \$2000.00 to the Paradise Valley, Dewberry, Kitscoty, Marwayne, and Vermilion Rescue Squads. The Rescue Squads will provide the County an annual statistical report outlining the past year's activities. This report must be submitted before any further funding will be made available.
- 3. The County of Vermilion River will make an annual donation for the sum of \$12,000.00 to the Lloydminster Rescue Squad. The Lloydminster Rescue Squad will provide to the County an annual statistical report outlining the past year's activities. This report must be submitted before any further funding will be made available.
