## **Policy Statement:**

The County of Vermilion River, in an effort to keep County intersections visible and safe, will consider conditions and requests when determining placement of stop signs.

## **Purpose:**

To keep intersections in the County visible and safe.

## **Policy:**

If any, one or a combination of the following criteria is met at an intersection, then a stop sign will be considered and brought to Council for approval:

- 1. Where the application of the normal right-hand rule would be unduly hazardous
- 2. Where the vehicle speed on the approach is less than 15km/hr due to the lack of visibility
- 3. Where visibility is less than 300 meters
- 4. Where higher traffic roads intersect or access an identified main traffic or "flow" road

The County will determine which roads will be designated as "flow" roads.

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
