Purpose:

The County of Vermilion River No. 24 recognizing the need and convenience of installing approved Texas Gates on road allowances within the County.

Guidelines:

Texas gates may only be authorized on municipal roads by motion of council. Landowners/companies requesting Texas Gates on municipal roads must install and accept total responsibility for the same. A form outlining these requirements must be signed by the person/company requesting the gate before the gate is to be installed; the applicant must also include the location and term of proposed use (Refer to Appendix "A").

It is the requesting parties` responsibilities to obtain written permission from adjacent landowners to the proposed Texas Gate installation site before the council motion is passed,

The Landowner/companies shall reimburse the County of Vermilion River No. 24 for all costs incurred by the County in maintaining the Texas Gate after the date of initial installations, including expenses for labour, materials, travel and equipment.

Texas Gates discovered on County road allowance that are not authorized by motion of council shall be removed unless the owner takes responsibility and makes application to have the gate approved by motion.

The County reserves the right to order Texas Gates to be removed at its discretion.
