Highway 893 at Islay single lane closed for rail crossing repair

Travelers will face a minor daytime delay starting May 27, 2025 at the CN Rail crossing on Highway 893, near the hamlet of Islay, as workers undertake rail systems repairs.

CN Rail requested 13 hours closure between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to allow workers time to repair the rail crossing.

Signs and automated flaggers will be on site to direct traffic and speeds will be reduced to 50 km/h. Motorists should use caution in this area. Fines for speeding are doubled in construction zones when workers are present.
